Partners in Stewardship Details

Your sponsorship of ALT through participation in this program will provide the critical support we need to sustainably care for one of our public conservation areas while demonstrating your commitment to the health and well-being of the greater community.

What do we ask of stewardship partners?

- Participation by a group of 5-25 employees in at least one 3-hour volunteer session
- Donation of \$3,000 toward the event and the on-going stewardship of that conservation area

What will ALT provide?

- Efficiently-run volunteer event providing employees an opportunity to feel good about giving back to their community
- Lunch, refreshments, tools, and supplies
- Sponsor's choice of a professionally conducted one-hour team-building activity, environmental education session, or in-nature social event at conclusion of the volunteer session
- Full recognition as stewardship partner in ALT communications

What tasks may be involved?

- Marking, maintaining, or building trails
- Removing invasive or nuisance plants
- Planting trees or other native vegetation
- Cleaning-up trash or debris
- Other depending upon needs of the area or skills of the volunteers
