New Projects on Recently-Protected Lands

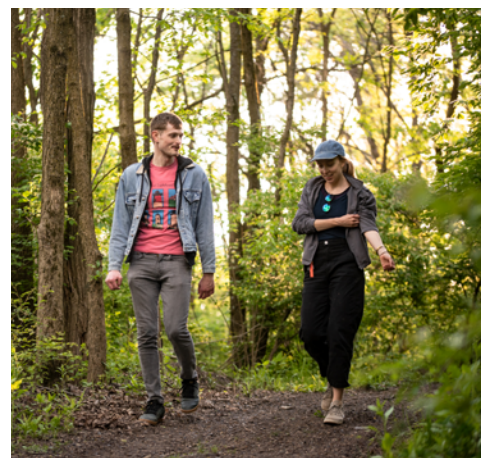
Last spring and summer, our stewardship team dove into the management of two new conservation areas and a unique conservation project. Girty's Woods and Churchill Valley Greenway were protected through the resounding community support and effort of many neighbors. In 2020, the Historic Walker-Ewing Log House was donated to ALT. In addition to national accreditation requirements for baseline stewardship, our team worked with consultants to begin planning efforts for long term management of these green spaces. Each year, April through September are months when our team are most active on lands moving restoration, trail, and other management goals forward. This year, we are excited to move forward on projects on the land and have many opportunities for those who want to get involved at any activity level.

CHURCHILL VALLEY GREENWAY

Working with La Quanta Bonci, we have developed a conceptual vision for the long-term future of the Greenway. The goal of this high-level plan was to help direct more in-depth management plans that will be developed over the next few years as funding is available. The next phase of management plans will really direct on the groundwork. In 2022, we can begin trail and invasive management work that is unlikely to be greatly impacted by future planning.

HISTORIC WALKER-EWING LOG HOUSE

The only project of this kind for ALT, the Historic Walker-Ewing Log House has provided a new view on conservation and stewardship. Our team is charged with maintaining the house, and this Spring we will be hosting a workday to clean indoors and prepare the surrounding landscape for plantings. That same day, the house will be open for free tours. If you're looking to learn more about volunteering with ALT or meet other volunteers, join us at the Log House for the Volunteer Meetup event.

GIRTY'S WOODS

In early 2022, consultants from Western Pa Conservancy and Pashek + MTR completed assessments of Girty's Woods and provided management recommendations focused on volunteer implementation. These recommendations will guide immediate activity to improve access and trail experience at the conservation area and will direct future planning for restoration projects. The final week of April we will kick off three months of volunteer trail activity at Girty's to begin implementation of trail recommendations.

How Can You Help? ALT get hundreds of offers of volunteer assistance each year from individuals throughout the county. While we try to match each volunteer with an impactful project, sometimes we don't have an active project on your favorite property. The best way to give your time in an effective way is to attend one of our scheduled workdays. Our team has planned these to tackle time sensitive projects and move necessary work forward. We can accomplish great things with 4 people, but we can really knock out a project with 14; so, we hope you and your group will join us!

Growing, Reflecting, and Forging Ahead Together

Pittsburgh is the City of Champions, and because of that tremendous work ethic and winning mindset, I thought many would appreciate this quote from legendary football coach, Vince Lombardi.

“People who work together will win, whether it be against complex football defenses or the problems of modern society.”

People who work together will win; and maybe more appropriate for off the field, working together will allow us to reach our goals, be more productive and provide an impact in the community. ALT's successes from 2021 are your successes, and here are a few examples I am proud of:

- Together, we protected about 500 acres across Allegheny and Butler counties, making it the most productive conservation year in our 28-year history. We would not have been able to protect these sensitive green spaces without hundreds of individual supporters and dozens of community and corporate partners. As a result, for the third year in a row, ALT was able to leverage local conservation dollars to attract over \$1 million in state investments back to the Pittsburgh region.
- Together, we have been able to bring our green spaces closer to all Allegheny County residents by conserving land throughout the county. In the last few years, our green spaces have gone from 12 miles to within 8 miles of every resident. Over 1,700 individual members have made this possible, so we recognize, appreciate and thank our members for their support.

- Together, we completed two master plans for Churchill Valley Greenway and Meyer Farm. This included countless hours of steering committee meetings, stakeholder charrettes, focus groups, one-on-one conversations, and surveys.

While 2021 was a challenging year, I look forward to the togetherness 2022 will bring. I look forward to going back to more in-person education programs and corporate/group volunteer events. I am eager to work with partners and community leaders to begin implementing our master plans. I look forward to enhanced stewardship activities at our new Girty's Woods Conservation Area. I am excited to see another round of our Sustainability at Home series which has been so well-received. We look forward to protecting more land throughout the region. Finally, I am excited to complete our second national reaccreditation certification and finalizing a revised strategic plan.

Modern society is facing serious challenges - landslides, poor water and air quality, food insecurity, flooding, physical and mental health; and all of these threats are exacerbated by the pandemic and loss of green space.

If you have not yet felt the sense of urgency to reverse these trends, now is the time. Individually and collectively, we can change course locally which will have a positive ripple effect with global climate impacts. We must act now – together – for a resilient community.

Healcrest: ALT's First Completed Urban Land Conservation Project

As an organization, we've had some very exciting moments to share with you in the last year - specifically, we have one more major "We did it!" moment to share with you. We closed on Phase 1 of the Healcrest project in the Garfield Neighborhood of Pittsburgh, making this our first official protected green space through our Community Conservation department.

This project was certainly met with several challenges, from fundraising during the pandemic to needing a contract extension, making our "We did it!" moment for this project extra special. We were also very excited to be awarded a \$69,400 grant from the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR) 2021 Community Conservation Partnerships Program (C2P2) Grants on December 30, 2021. This is our first DCNR grant for green space protection in the Community Conservation program overall.

Since 2019, ALT, the Bloomfield-Garfield Corporation (BGC), and surrounding community members have been working together to permanently protect the green space that was formerly home to the Healcrest Urban Farm. The entirety of the project will protect 1.5 acres and is made up of 15 individual parcels. The land ALT closed on in December is the Phase One and protects 7 of the 15 parcels.

The group's draft plans re-imagine the small parcels of farmland as a gathering space for Environmental Charter School (ECS) Middle students, and the surrounding community, that could help preserve the land's organic soils, apple trees and other vital amenities. This vision was guided by the Garfield Green Zone Plan, the Garfield 2030 Plan and the Garfield Community Trail plan, all of which were created by local stakeholders with neighborhood goals in mind.

ALT and a select group of stakeholders - comprised of neighbors of the green space, the BGC, Grounded Strategies, and ECS Middle - worked together to secure the land under contract, draft a vision plan, kick-start fundraising efforts and begin minor site clean-up. Please wait to visit the site, we want to leave space for the trail building project in the neighborhood to get underway this spring!

We have more projects in the works, along with working on Phase Two of this project, and hope to have many more updates to share with everyone this year!

As a teenager, Katie Perrotti spent time at home, school, her job at Borders, and her second home at “The Slag Dumps” – a former mine waste site that was slowly being reclaimed by nature, now known as “Bethel Green Conservation Area”.

“Growing up, every kid has a sort of stomping grounds; The Slag Dumps were mine. For a while, I basically lived there when I wasn’t at school or work,” Perrotti said. “The woods feels like home to me. Back then, my friends and I would camp there overnight and watch the sunrise.”

Coming from a very “indoors family”, Perrotti was inspired by the contrast of the woods’ wildness; and when she eventually joined the Girl Scouts, she had the chance to connect with and learn more about this wildness. While she had been developing an affinity for the outdoors, she attributes the root of her love for the outdoors to her Girl Scout Troop leader who ensured their troop took camping trips and got their hands dirty.

“I feel so lucky that we were one of few scout troops that still camped and still do – because I’m the troop leader now,” Perrotti said. “When I was 18, I became a Girl Scout Leader, a mom, and a wife all in one year.”

Perrotti’s love for the outdoors only grew as her family did, and she ensures her scouts and her family connect with the outdoors frequently. She took her kids to Bethel Green often, warning them – each time the land changed hands - that the land could become houses in a few years. So, when Perrotti learned of Allegheny Land Trust’s campaign to protect the land forever, she jumped into action helping to raise funds and awareness for the project.

“Bethel Green is a near-and-dear outdoor place to me,” Perrotti said. “And I loved being able to explain to my kids why it was so special for mommy to be part of protecting it.”



Since the land’s protection, Perrotti has volunteered along Bethel Green’s trails weekly helping to install and update signage, clear trails, manage native and invasive species, and to remove trash. She is often hauling a wheelbarrow via a climbing harness, covered in mud, and beaming a big smile as she improves Bethel Green.

When she is not maintaining and improving the space, she’s enjoying it. Perrotti loves to geocache, run, and hike at Bethel Green, other ALT green spaces, and on wild lands across the region. In addition to being a mother to six kids, leading a Girl Scout troop, and volunteering with ALT, Perrotti spends her time volunteering with her kids’ schools, lending a hand at community clean-

up days, and – if she must be indoors – playing her baby grand piano.

“I’m a feral outdoor she-beast—I’m into any activity that puts me outside,” Perrotti said. “The outdoors has been so therapeutic—it’s such a big part of my life. I want to pass that onto another generation, which I try to do as a Scout Leader. I feel like it’s my job because it was so important that it was passed along to me to me. Even if 1 or 2 girls find meaning in it, that would mean everything to me.”

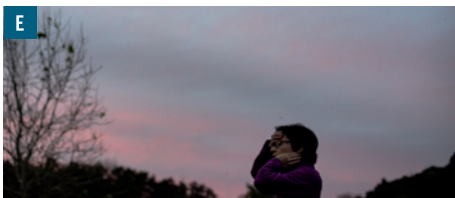

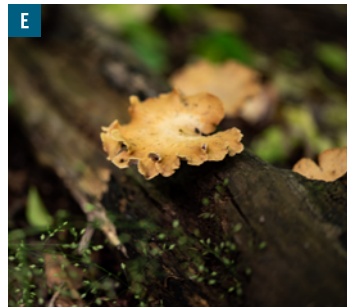

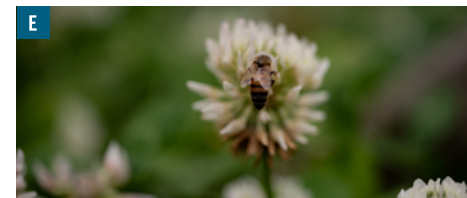
